

# Scrubbers How To

**Operation** 



• Unplug battery charger if currently charging.

 Install pad driver(s) and pad(s) or brush(es).



 Verify recovery tank is empty and vacuum shut-off is operational.

• Fill solution tank.



• Turn machine on.



• Select appropriate water setting and pad pressure.



 Start pad(s)/brush(es) and vacuum.



• Turn off machine and empty recovery tank into drain.



• Lower squeegee and begin scrubbing.



• To continue scrubbing, repeat steps 3-7.



 Once recovery tank is full, shut off water, pad(s)/brush(es), vacuum, and lift squeegee.



## Scrubbers How To

Storage

• Turn the machine off.

• Empty and rinse the recovery tank and vacuum shut-off.



• Leave recovery tank open to air dry.

• Charge batteries using the appropriate charger.



 Verify squeegee is not streaking. If it is, clean or adjust squeegee. If streaking persists, rotate or replace blades.



• Charge batteries after each use.

## **Daily Maintenance**



- Check pad(s)/brushes for wear and replace as needed.
- Rinse and flip pads daily.



• Verify vacuum shut-off device is working properly.



# Scrubbers How To

## Weekly Maintenance



• Check solution filter for debris.

 If equipped with wetacid batteries check battery water level (see Battery Maintenance).



• Check recovery system for vacuum leaks.

• Check tires for damage or wear.

### Monthly Maintenance



• Lubricate moving parts as described by the User's Manual.



• Verify all fasteners, pins, etc. are in place and tight.
