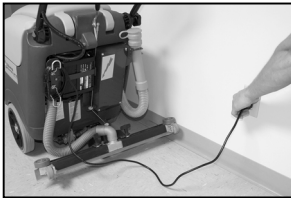


Scrubbers How To

Operation

1



- Unplug battery charger if currently charging.

2



- Install pad driver(s) and pad(s) or brush(es).

3



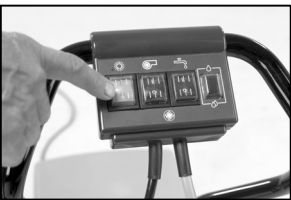
- Verify recovery tank is empty and vacuum shut-off is operational.

4



- Fill solution tank.

5



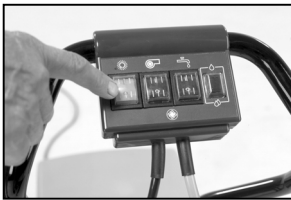
- Turn machine on.

6



- Select appropriate water setting and pad pressure.

7



- Start pad(s)/brush(es) and vacuum.

8



- Lower squeegee and begin scrubbing.

9



- Once recovery tank is full, shut off water, pad(s)/brush(es), vacuum, and lift squeegee.

10



- Turn off machine and empty recovery tank into drain.

11

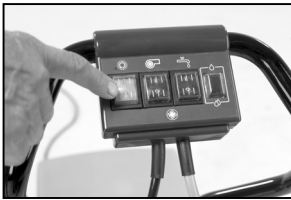


- To continue scrubbing, repeat steps 3-7.

Scrubbers How To

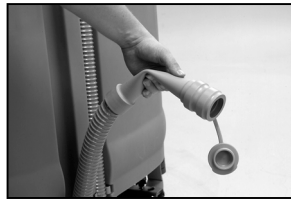
Storage

1



- Turn the machine off.

2



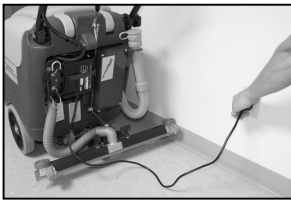
- Empty and rinse the recovery tank and vacuum shut-off.

3



- Leave recovery tank open to air dry.

4



- Charge batteries using the appropriate charger.

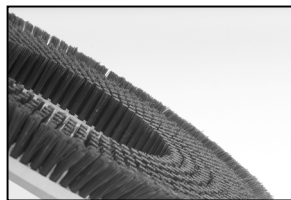
Daily Maintenance

1



- Verify squeegee is not streaking. If it is, clean or adjust squeegee. If streaking persists, rotate or replace blades.

2



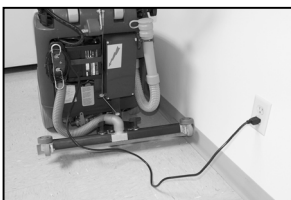
- Check pad(s)/brushes for wear and replace as needed.
- Rinse and flip pads daily.

3



- Verify vacuum shut-off device is working properly.

4

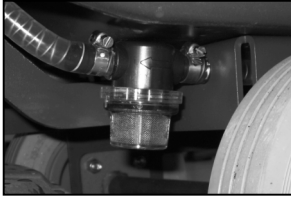


- Charge batteries after each use.

Scrubbers How To

Weekly Maintenance

1



- Check solution filter for debris.

2



- If equipped with wet-acid batteries check battery water level (see Battery Maintenance).

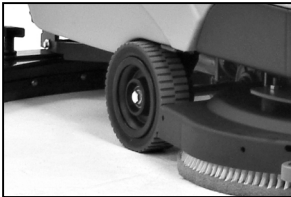

- Check recovery system for vacuum leaks.

Monthly Maintenance

1



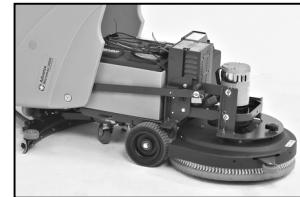
- Check tires for damage or wear.

2



- Lubricate moving parts as described by the User's Manual.

3



- Verify all fasteners, pins, etc. are in place and tight.
